

FACT SHEET

1. What makes your university UNIQUE?

The University of Calgary is a part of the U15 (top research institutions) in Canada and a top 200 university in the world (QS). We are located in Calgary – the 5th most livable city in the world which is also a 1 hour flight away from Vancouver. Our university serves over 31,000 students in more than 200 undergraduate, graduate and professional degree programs. We are also one of the few universities in Canada who offers a combined Engineering and Commerce undergraduate degree.

2. What are your programs of study?

3. Do you require TOEFL or IELTS scores?

4. What is your average/minimum IB score?

We do not set minimum entrance grades as the entrance requirement is set on a competitive basis and therefore varies by year and program. For estimates based on previous years, please visit this link and select the appropriate fields:

5. Do you offer admissions to candidates with IGCSE scores (only)?

If a student is studying IGCSE, they will need to provide additional results such as the GCE (A2 level), AS (Advanced Subsidiary) or IB as well.

6. What is the average class size?

We have a faculty to student ratio of 21:1, however students should expect larger class sizes in the first 1-2 years of their studies.

7. What is the yearly cost for international students?

Tuition + books/supplies cost + general fees for international students completing 10 courses a year (5 courses per semester, 2 semesters per year) is around CAD\$22,000 for one academic year (i.e. 8 months). Including living costs the range is CAD\$31,000-37,000.

8. Do you offer international students scholarships?

Yes - to be considered for competitive awards available to undergraduate students, prospective students need to apply for admission to the University of Calgary before they can apply for awards since the UCID (or student ID) is required on the application.

Please note that students do not need to be admitted to the University before submitting an awards application. We advise our international students to secure other financial support because even if awarded, scholarships/awards may only cover a portion of their University tuition and fees.

All applications are completed online. UCalgary has intake for new undergraduate students only in the Fall (September) of each year. Applications for Fall (September) 2017 currently closed. The next available intake is September 2018, and the application will open online here in October 2017.
